SHOW RULES

1. All classes, with the exception of Class 69 are open to all members of the British Cactus and Succulent Society (BCSS).
2. Class 69 is for Branches within Zone 6 only and entries should be assembled from the collections of at least three members of that Branch.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries per class (except Class 69). No fee is made for entry and no prize money will be awarded.
4. Entries must be made on the official form and sent by post or electronically to Mr G. Hughes, 12 Egerton Road, Berkhamsted, Hertfordshire HP4 1DT(email gandhel@o2.co.uk). Entries must reach Mr Hughes before 10am on 20 May 2010.
5. Plants must be the personal property of the exhibitor; jointly owned entries will be accepted in the family name, e.g. Mr and Mrs....
6. No pot may contain more than one plant, except where plants are grafted.
7. Max. pot sizes given in the Schedule are the maximum allowed and are measured inside the rim to within 3mm ($\frac{1}{8}$ ").
8. Admission to the show is free to exhibitors who make a minimum of five entries.
9. All entries must be staged by 10.45am on 22 May 2010. No staging of plants will be allowed after 10.45am.
10. Final staging/arranging of exhibits is left to authorised Show Stewards
11. No exhibit may be removed before the end of the show without the permission of the Show Secretary.
12. Plant classification and judging will be in accordance with the BCSS "Handbook of Shows", 9th Edition 2003.
13. Judging objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary by 3pm. The Judge's reviewed decision is final.
14. All cups and trophies are perpetual challenge awards and remain the property of Zone 6 BCSS.
15. Trophy winners are required to sign a receipt and to undertake to return awards in good time for the next show.
16. Any award may be withheld by the Judges if there is no exhibit of sufficient merit.
17. Liability for Loss: All exhibits, personal property etc., are displayed at the owner's risk and no responsibility is accepted for loss or damage by any cause whatsoever, although normal care will be taken.
18. Entry in the show constitutes acceptance of the Rules.

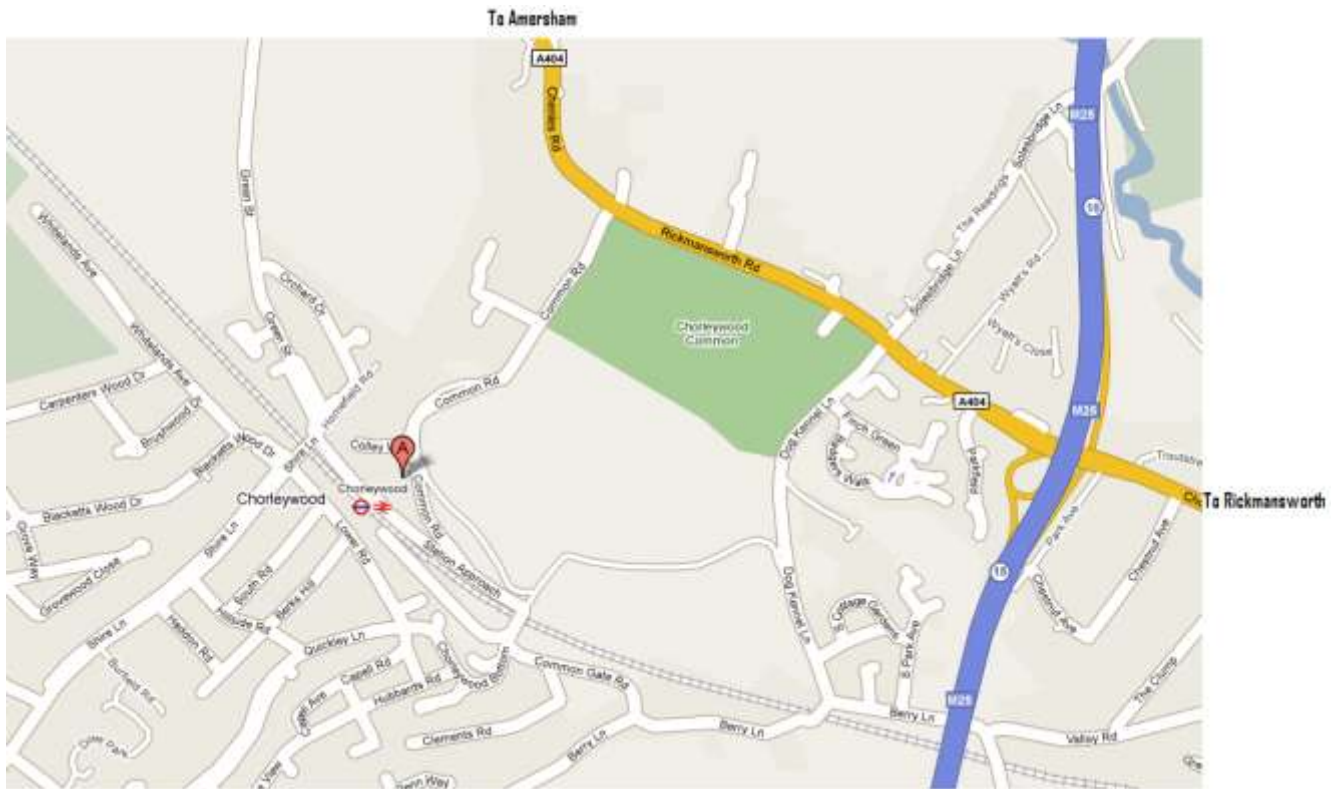
